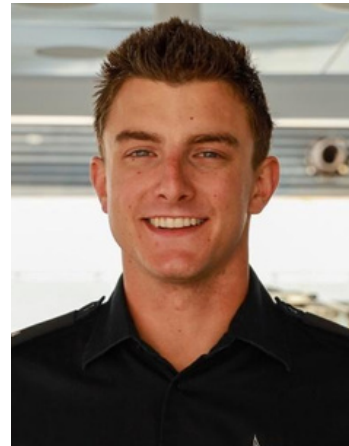

Then it was the boss live aboard in LA where I would assist on deck where I could and make a lighter workload for everyone else. Once boss left we delivered the boat from Los Angeles through the Panama Canal to Fort Lauderdale where we would begin our Bahamas charter season
